We had the opportunity to give out Bibles to people in church who didn't have Bibles.

One lady was held up and the thieves took her bag and her Bible. A man that was helping me hadn't ever had a Bible, he sure was pleased. Two older teenagers who go to another church didn't have Bibles and now they have God's word to read.

Thank you for your prayers for the men's conference. It went very well with men coming from four areas of the country. There were four pastors plus a gentleman that is going to start a new mission work and other men seeking to serve the Lord in a greater way. I taught six hours on leaders with a vision. My two grandsons gave short lessons on the importance of a vision and vision with a method. Both of them have successful businesses and are very active in church. A man's vision affects his relationship with the Lord, affects his home and welfare and affects his church and community. Without a vision souls are lost.
