We have some very sad news. Our oldest son, Leslie, long time missionary to Honduras, has recently found out that his wife, Alba has cancer.

Alba has been very sick for many months but was not diagnosed with cancer until about four weeks ago. Leslie took Alba to Dallas, Texas to one of the best cancer doctors and she is to start cancer therapy Monday. She has had many health problems to get under control before starting the therapy and has been in and out of the hospital many times.

Lena also received some bad news on her eyes. The operation on the retina was very successful but she has some very severe cornea damage. She can't be fitted with glasses and therefore is unable to read. She is under treatment by the doctor in Fort Worth but is able to be in Honduras. In December she will return to the doctor for the next step in the treatment. Please be in prayer that it can be restored without a transplant.

Honduras is still under tight control for the virus. We can only do business one day a week and still cannot have church services on Sunday. We continue preaching by zoom and we have a small gathering of people in one of our homes for Wednesday afternoon and Thursday afternoon.

We hope to get started on the construction of the church building in ten days. I am buying materials to start with and getting together some workers to start. We are praying that with special offerings we will be able to soon have a roof over our heads.

Thank you for your prayers. We have had so many obstacles to hinder the work and you prayers are very important.
